- Completion of ACC 1210 will be articulated as ACC 2AC and satisfy ACC 200 requirement for Dietetics Program at UD.
- Students must earn a minimum grade of C in BIO 1171, BIO 1272, CHE 1211, and CHE 1221 in order to fulfill the pre-requisite requirement for professional schools.
- Completion of both CHE 1211 and CHE 1221 are required for transfer credit to fulfill Chemistry requirements.
- COM 2206 or 2211 will meet the communication requirement at the University of Dayton with the completion of the Associate Degree. This exception applies to only UD-Sinclair Academy students.
- SOC 1101 will meet the social science integrated course requirement at the University of Dayton with the completion of the Associate Degree.
- PHL 1XC at UD will substitute for PHL 103 requirement. This exception applies to only UD-Sinclair Academy students. Consult with your UD advisor if you are eligible for this exception.
- REL 1XC at UD will substitute for REL 103 requirement. This exception applies to only UD-Sinclair Academy students. Consult with your UD advisor if you are eligible for this exception.
- It is recommended that students take at least 15 hours per semester at Sinclair.
- 54 semester hours must be taken from a four-year college or university, and the last 30 semester hours must be taken at the University of Dayton.
- Students must meet with the UD advisor before acceptance into this program.
- 120 hours minimum are required for BSHS. Required GPA at the time of the Associate Degree is 3.0. Hours may change based on program requirements.
- This program requires courses to be taken in summers.
