- Students must meet with the University of Dayton advisor before acceptance into this program.
- EDT 110 and Lab course, The Profession of Teaching, is required by the University of Dayton to be successfully completed by <u>all</u> students in the Department of Teacher Education. For current Sinclair students accepted into the UD-Sinclair Academy, this course may be taken at the University of Dayton, at no cost to the student, while still taking classes at Sinclair. The University of Dayton advisors can provide information regarding eligibility and registration. We strongly encourage Academy students to take EDT 110 and Lab at the University of Dayton prior to transitioning to the University of Dayton. Please note that EDT 110 and lab also be used for Sinclair's EDU 1100 when required for the associate degree.
- COM 2206 or 2211 will meet the communication requirement at the University of Dayton with the completion of the Associate Degree. This applies to UD-Sinclair Academy students only.
- PSY 1100 or SOC 1101 will meet the social science integrated course requirement at the University of Dayton with the completion of the Associate Degree.
- PHL 1XC at UD will substitute for PHL 103 requirement. This exception applies to only UD-Sinclair Academy students. Consult with your UD advisor if you are eligible for this exception.
- REL 1XC at UD will substitute for REL 103 requirement. This exception applies to only UD-Sinclair Academy students. Consult with your UD advisor if you are eligible for this exception.
- 124 hours minimum are required for BSE. Required GPA at the time of the Associate Degree is 3.0.
- 54 semester hours must be taken at a 4-year college or university, and the last 30 semester hours must be taken at the University of Dayton.
- Hours may change based on changes in licensure and/or program requirements.
- Students are strongly recommended to begin their University of Dayton programs fall term.
- Conflicts of times of courses may result in course changes in the last four terms at the University of Dayton.
- It is recommended that students take at least 15 hours per semester at Sinclair.

Students must select Sinclair courses from TWO of the following concentration areas to fulfill the remaining hours (20) for the Associate Degree and for University of Dayton courses to be taken in four (4) semesters.
