- **Students must successfully complete Visual Arts Review with the UD's Art and Design Department during the spring semester of their last term in their Sinclair program in order to continue transitioning into the BA degree in Art History at UD.**
- **124 hours minimum are required for a BA degree at UD. Required GPA at the time of the Associate Degree is 3.0.**
