- **VAR 100 Visual Arts Foundation requirement will be waived when UD-Sinclair Academy students in this degree pathway transition to UD. This exception applies to only UD-Sinclair Academy students. Consult with your UD advisor if you are eligible for this exception.**
- **Students must successfully complete Visual Arts Review with the UD's Art and Design Department during the spring semester of their last term in their Sinclair program in order to continue transitioning into the BA degree in Visual Arts at UD.**
- **124 hours minimum are required for a BA degree at UD. Required GPA at the time of the Associate Degree is 3.0.**
